What started out as introductions and a few beers with a couple of Encounter visitors from New England in the Revere Tavern in Paradise, PA in 2011 turned into exploratory discussions of doing something together that would bring a lot of Healeys and their owners together for the first time in a long while. Little did I know how much work, coordination, and compromise it would take to bring that fly in the sky idea to fruition.

FLASH forward almost 4 years and I arrived at the Gateway Gettysburg Campus in mid-afternoon on Friday, July 17 to begin setup of what would become the largest Austin Healey event held in the Mid Atlantic states in 25 or more

years. Over 650 attendees from points East, West, South and North were converging on this historic crossroads town in more than 240 Healeys and assorted BJ9's to celebrate the marque, see old friends and meet new ones over the course of five action packed days.

Our Planning Committee of 3 representatives from the Philly Region of AHSTC and 3 representatives from the New England Region of the AHCA had spent countless hours going over every detail, every day's event, everything we could anticipate given our combined experiences at past Encounters and Conclaves. Now it was show time. What might go wrong? What did we forget? How well could we adapt on the fly? Would the weather Gods be kind? Having never run an Encounter, much less a combined meet triple the size, I had trepidations but was convinced that we could pull off a memorable event. With the focus and can do attitudes possessed by Trish Woglom and Leo Kob as well as the same commitment from our New England partners, I was confident that our extensive planning efforts would pay off.

At the risk of being called a braggart - pull it off we did! By all accounts that we've heard so far, Enclave 2015 was an outstanding success! Some of the highlights included:

- **Raising more than \$12,000 for the Fisher House Foundation and the DMH Memorial Fund at the always entertaining Charity Auction hosted by Alex Tricarb;**
- **Strolling in glorious weather through the Popular Car Show with more than 200 exquisite Healeys on the show field. It was an overwhelming experience that gathered more than a dozen 100M's, 60+ BJ8's , 25+ Bugeyes and outstanding examples of each and every Austin Healey regular production model;**
- **Laughing and smiling kids creating candy cars and frantically completing in a very creative obstacle course in**

the Kiddiekhana;

- Racing Go-karts and playing miniature golf while enjoying ice cream in the aftermath of the car show;
- Competing in a very fast Gymkhana and hilarious Civil War Funkhana in perhaps the best locale for these events in memory at the Battlefield Harley Davidson parking lots;
- Putting Gerry Coker “through the hoops” at the Ladies Fashion Show hosted by Mrs. and General Ulysses S Grant accompanied by the beautiful harp music of Marti Kob;
- Observing a detailed Concours judging of 100’s, a 100M, BJ8’s, a 100-6 and Bugeye’s;
- Enjoying the great food at our closing banquet where more than 130 awards were given to the attendees for their cars and their talents; and
- Meeting old, and making new, friends throughout a week of fun and informative festivities.

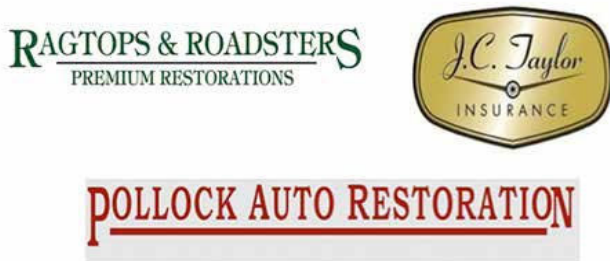

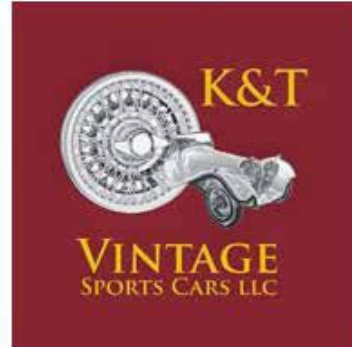
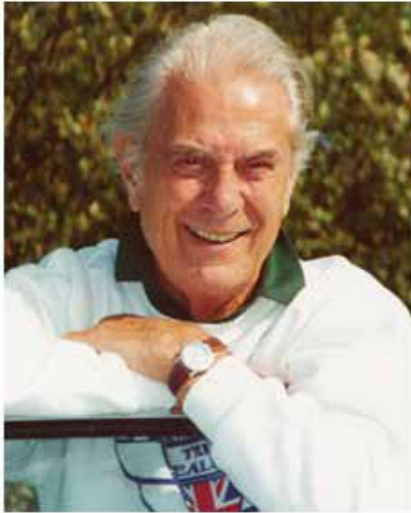
